#### For volunteers

Make a difference to your community and the issues you care about. Whatever your skills or experience, training is often available. Opportunities range from an hour or two a month, to a day or two a week or one off activities.

Out of pocket expenses are usually paid, and these payments don't affect taxes/benefits. Volunteering roles are varied and could include:

- Work with young people: sports coaching, holiday, pre-school and after school clubs.

- Team building through employer supported volunteering.
